**CONSENT ORDER**

**UPON** the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant's application by Application Notice dated 22 December 2018 to adjourn the trial of this matter listed for 20 – 28 January 2020

**AND UPON** the Claimant agreeing to a stay in order to allow the Business Banking Resolution Service ("**BBRS**") to make a decision on the eligibility of the Defendants for the BBRS (an "**eligibility decision**"), and, if so eligible, a determination in relation to the issues in dispute in these proceedings.

**BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

- 1) The trial listed for 20 – 28 January 2020 is hereby vacated;
- 2) This case is stayed until 17 July 2020;
- 3) The Claimant is to notify the Court prior to the expiry of the stay whether the BBRS has made an eligibility decision in the Defendants' case. If, by 17 July 2020, the BBRS:
  - a. Has not yet made an eligibility decision in the Defendants' case, their application to the BBRS not having been withdrawn, or has made an eligibility decision in the Defendants' favour, then the stay at paragraph 2 above is automatically extended for a further 6 months.
  - b. Has made an eligibility decision and the BBRS's decision is that the Defendants are not eligible, the Claimant shall write to the court seeking relisting of the trial;

4) No order as to costs.
